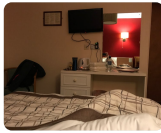
BUT FIRST, a stop to admire the ruins of Urquhart Castle on a scenic cruise of Loch Ness.

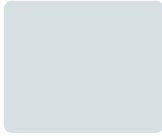
